### Counting Problems - Part 1


1. There were 11 books on a shelf and 2 books are borrowed. 3 books were returned, some children read. How many books were left on the shelf?




2. A shop sells pencils. Each box contains 8 pencils. There are 2 full boxes of pencils. 4 pencils are purchased. How many pencils are left?
