Value: the lightness to darkness of a hue.

Monochromatic Colors are all the colors (hue) and shades of a single hue.

• Tint is a hue (a color) + white added

• Shade is a hue (a color) + black added

white	white + white = tint	white + black = shade	white + black = gray	white
yellow	yellow + white = tint	yellow + black = shade	yellow + black = gray	yellow
blue	blue + white = tint	blue + black = shade	blue + black = gray	blue

• Shade is a hue (a color) + black added

• Tint is a hue (a color) + white added

red	red + white = tint	red + black = shade	red + black = gray	red
green	green + white = tint	green + black = shade	green + black = gray	green
purple	purple + white = tint	purple + black = shade	purple + black = gray	purple
