

creating value and changing its temperature

Value: the lightness or darkness of a color is called its VALUE.

Tints are light colors that are made by mixing a color with white.

Tones are dark colors that are made by mixing a color with black.

Temperature is how warm or cool a color is.

Transparency: the ability to let light through.

Opacity: the ability to NOT let light through.
