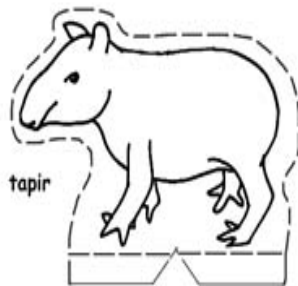
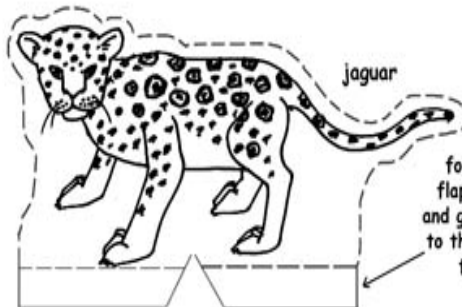
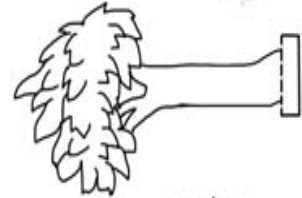
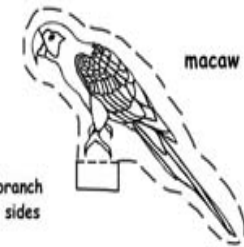
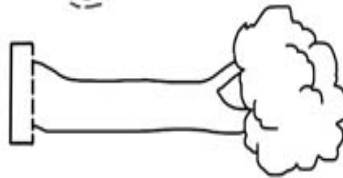


## Amazon Rainforest Animals for Diorama Displays

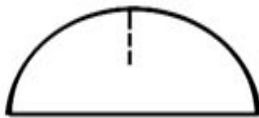
- 1) To share with your class, copy this sheet onto heavy stock paper (preferably card stock).
- 2) Have each student color the animals.
- 3) Cut out the animals leaving the flaps under them for gluing.
- 4) Fold them back and glue them to the jungle floor or the sides (branches).
- 5) For free standing animals cut out the stands and along the dotted line and slide them each onto their animal cross-wise to hold it up.



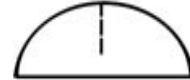
- 1) tail over the branch - tab behind the branch
