

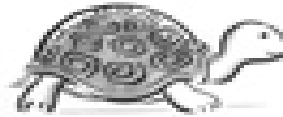
Big, bigger, biggest



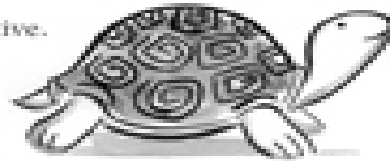
Look below to see how we change the "amount" that an adjective expresses.



Big is an adjective.



Bigger is a **comparative** adjective.
It is used to compare two things.



Biggest is a **superlative** adjective.
It is used when comparing three or more things.
