

Decision Making Graphic Organizer

This graphic organizer is suitable for students in elementary school. Follow the steps below:

- **Step 1:** Read a page or two from a story.
- **Step 2:** Write a central event, with the immediate effects caused by the original action. The next step is to draw additional connecting lines if they are needed.
- **Step 3:** Write secondary thoughts with the sequential effects regarding the effects within the event. The next step is to draw additional connecting thoughts if they are needed.
- **Step 4:** Circle references to the topic effect or event in their paragraph that will generally be identified with the topic effect.
