Direct and Indirect Quotes

Identify direct and indirect quotations.

Read each sentence carefully. Write indirect or direct for each sentence. Add quotation marks for all direct quotes.

A direct quotation is a person's exact words in writing. Quotation marks enclose these words.

Example: "How are you?" asked George.

An indirect quotation does not use a person's exact words. There are no quotation marks.

Example: Mrs. Smith told us to bring hats for the field trip.
