## Conflict Notes & Practices:

Man vs. Man, Man vs. Nature, Man vs. Self

### Categories of Conflict:

#### External

Character opposing an outside force!

Man vs. Nature: the character is opposing a force of nature (e.g. a storm)

Man vs. Man: the person is opposing another character (e.g. a rival)

#### Internal

Character struggling with a conflict from within

Man vs. Self: the character is struggling with an internal dilemma (e.g. moral). There is no clear right or wrong, good or evil. The character must make a difficult decision.

However, the character will grow and develop as a result of the conflict.
