


Land heats and cools faster than water. In the summer it gets hot (low pressure) but the ocean is still cold (High pressure) so the air goes to land. But in the winter the land has cooled but the ocean hasn't so the wind goes to the ocean

9. Draw, label, and explain the change of seasons on the earth complete with Solstices, and Equinoxes and the dates of their occurrences.



The summer solstice is when the sun is out the longest of the year, winter is the shortest, and the Equinoxes are equal (12hrs day, 12hrs night)
