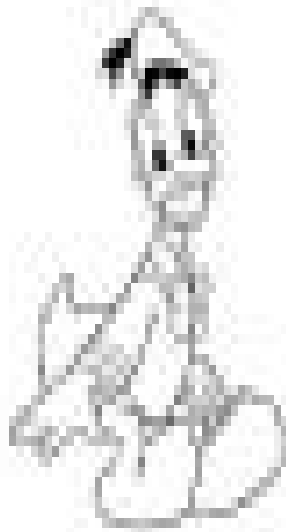


## Praxis
