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Paragraph Writing

A paragraph usually has:

- 1) **A topic sentence.** The sentence tells what the paragraph is all about.
- 2) **Supporting sentences.** These sentences tell more about the topic.
- 3) **A concluding sentence.** This sentence brings together all of the other sentences and often reminds the topic.

Always put the topic sentence first and the topic sentence last. Put the supporting sentences in between the beginning and end.
