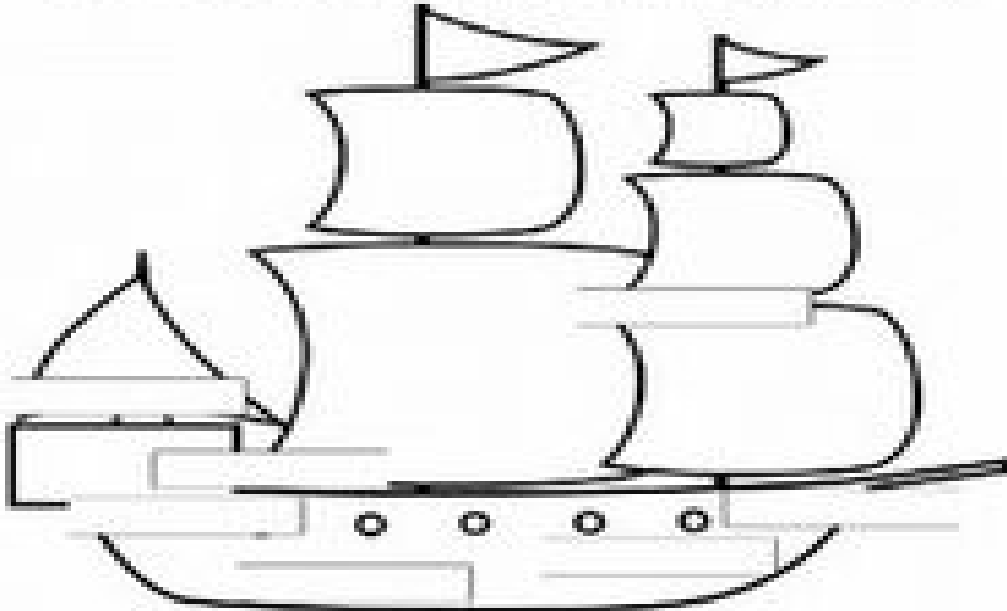

Parts of the Mayflower

Vocabulary of the Ship's Components

The Rigging: The location of the sails and ropes that control the speed of the ship.

Wreckle (Hatchways): The "hatches" inside the Mayflower, the place where the cords were coiled.

Lower Decks: The living quarters for the Pilgrims, the area they stayed in during their voyage.

Hold: The lowest where food and other supplies were stored.

Wheelway: The location of the wheel that controlled the ship's rudder and turning.

The Great Cabin: The living quarters of the master/captain, chief officers and ship's apprentice.

The Round Room: The room where the master/captain charted the ship's course.
