## Adjectives

60 Directions: Add an adjective that describes the underlined noun. Write your new sentence on the line.

Articles are special kinds of adjectives. The articles "a" and "an" are used to name a non-specific noun. We use the article "an" if the noun it describes begins with a **vowel sound** (not just a vowel). We use the article "a" if the noun it describes begins with a **consonant sound** (not just a consonant).

Example: a dog (consonant /d/ sound); a helicopter (consonant /h/ sound)
an apple (vowel /a/ sound); an honor (silent h, vowel /o/ sound)
