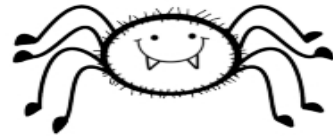




# October Choice Board

Level ONE	<p><u>Word Boxes</u></p> <p>Write your words and then make a box around each letter, following the shape of the letter</p>	<p><u>Short and Tall</u></p> <p>Write your words 3 times: regular, really tall and skinny, and really short and squatty</p>	<p><u>Forwards and Backwards</u></p> <p>Write your words forwards (regular) and backwards</p>
Level TWO	<p><u>Word Search</u></p> <p>Make a word search puzzle with all of your words. Circle or highlight each word.</p>	<p><u>ABC Order</u></p> <p>Write each word arranging the letters in ABC order Example: closet would be celost</p>	<p><u>Reverse ABC</u></p> <p>Write your words in reverse ABC order</p>
Level THREE	<p><u>Synonyms</u></p> <p>Write a synonym for each word</p>	<p><u>Parts of Speech</u></p> <p>Classify the words according to the part of speech</p>	<p><u>Add 'Em Up</u></p> <p>If consonants = 10 and vowels = 5, how much is each word worth? Add up the values of each word.</p>
Level FOUR	<p><u>Song</u></p> <p>Write a song using all of your spelling words. You can use a familiar song like Row, Row, Row Your Boat.</p>	<p><u>Guide Words</u></p> <p>Look up your words in the dictionary and find 10 of your words. Write down the page number along with the two guide words.</p>	<p><u>Class Story</u></p> <p>Write a story using all of your spelling words and include students from your class</p>
