

# BRAIN RING

## Game rules:

1. Students are divided into groups of 4-6
2. Choosing the captain.
3. First only members are invited to the game, the captain answers questions and sets score (if the score is equal).
4. Decide which team is the first and then their captain picks up the number of questions for himself.
5. When the question is read, the team has 30 seconds to discuss and give the answer.
6. If the answer is correct the captain gets a point. If not, the other team can answer the right last option.
7. In case that the team answers another team's question correctly they have to continue the game and their take turns.
8. When the 2 minutes are over, the captain suggests the judge what the result is and choose the winner.
9. In order to be better, students shouldn't show out their answer as they get disappointed – opportunities to their total score.
10. Each member should have the opportunity to answer, but they can choose to answer the captain only. But there will be such a rule that one player's mistakes can answer without discussing with his team members, even if he or she is not alone in answering them.
11. If there are more than 2 teams, each team should play the game in order to be better and choose the most intelligent player.
