

$$-2x + 3y = -9$$

$$-2x + 3y + 2x = -9 + 2x$$

$$3y = 2x - 9$$

$$\frac{3y}{3} = \frac{2x - 9}{3}$$

$$y = \frac{2}{3}x - 3$$

$$4x - 6y = 18$$

$$4x - 6y - 4x = 18 - 4x$$

$$-6y = -4x + 18$$

$$\frac{-6y}{-6} = \frac{-4x + 18}{-6}$$

$$y = \frac{-4}{-6}x + \frac{18}{-6}$$

$$y = \frac{2}{3}x - 3$$

$$\begin{cases} -2x + 3y = -9 \\ 4x - 6y = 18 \end{cases} \Rightarrow \begin{cases} y = \frac{2}{3}x - 3 \\ y = \frac{2}{3}x - 3 \end{cases}$$
