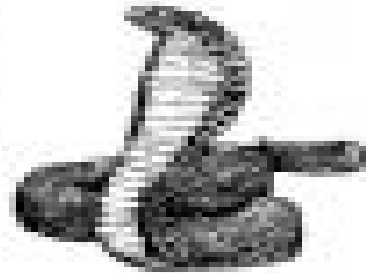


## Venomous reptiles

Crocodiles are the only poisonous (or venomous) reptiles apart from two species of lizard. Venomous snakes bite accidents but the most venomous species are found in tropical areas. Snake-eyes get poison or venom into your body usually by a bite or scratch or sting. Usually, these fangs are positioned at the front of the upper jaw, on the sides and behind, but in some species they are located at the back. Watch what the prey or snake can do at all. Sometimes it is used for defense.



The fangs of most venomous snakes fold over in the mouth when they are not needed. When the snake opens its mouth to strike, the fangs flip forward. The snake's open head is a warning sign to other animals from attacking it. Most snakes will try to avoid a fight, seeking more peace.
