



## Rounding up

Use the **rounding up** method to multiply these amounts. Remember to **round one number to the nearest 10** and **adjust the answer**. For example:

## 49 × 6 is the same as:

50 × 6 minus 1 × 6 300 - 6 = **294**

- 2.29 × 4
- 3. 38 × 3
- 4. 47 × 7
- 5.69 × 5
- 6.79 × 2
- $7.88 \times 5$
- 8. 97 × 6
