

William Shakespeare

Shakespeare was born on April 23rd 1564 in Stratford-upon-Avon, son of John Shakespeare and Mary Arden. He studied at The King's New School. At the age of 18, Shakespeare married the 26-year-old Anne Hathaway with whom he had three children: Susanna, and twins Hamnet and Judith. He began a successful career in London as an actor, writer, and part owner of a playing company. He became the greatest writer in the English language and the world's dramatist. He died on April 23rd in Stratford-upon-Avon, England.
