## Skin Disorder Project

- 1. Each student will be assigned a skin disorder.
- Students are to research their skin disorder and prepare a short oral presentation (2-3 Minutes) for the class. The following items are to be addressed in your presentation:
  - a. Description of the disorder
  - b. Signs & symptoms
  - c. Treatment
- 3. Each student is to create a poster to present during the oral presentation. The poster is not to be any smaller than the standard poster board size. The poster should include pictures of the skin disorder you are presenting to the class, as well as other educational information that you feel would be important. The pictures can be in color or black & white.

Important points to remember:

- Make sure you understand what you are presenting. Do NOT use terms that you have no idea what they mean.
- Do NOT include pictures that show genitals or other body parts that would not be appropriate to display publicly.
- Use your poster as a visual aid during your presentation to enhance what you are saying.
- You may NOT "read" your oral presentation.
- The poster board can be any color.
- Your presentation should be prepared for an audience that has no healthcare background.
- Be prepared for questions from the audience.
- Your poster board may be displayed around the THS campus, so keep this in mind.
- The more you practice what you're going to say, the less nervous you'll be!
