

Instructions

This workbook is designed to allow you to decide what decision parameters are important to you in evaluating and selecting colleges, and then rating each school on these parameters.

Place your own criteria rank from 1 to 10 in the "Degree of Importance" column (col C). 1 is not important and 10 is the highest in importance. Rank each decision parameter.

In the column for each school, place an evaluation for each school and each decision parameter. Use the same 1 to 10 scale, 1 being a poor rating and 10 being the best rating. (this number will go in the left column for each school)

The right column for each school will calculate the rating value for the school given the weight you put on the criteria (col C) and your judgment on that characteristic at the school.

The higher the overall number for the school, the more favorable you see the school given all the weighed ratings you have completed.

* This tool is not meant to be a definitive decision tool, but rather a way to organize your thoughts and put relative weights on decision criteria, then your own rating of the school on that criteria.

* You may decide NOT to go to the school with the highest overall number - which may indicate that other factors not listed have influenced your judgment.
