## Life Cycle of Frogs

Learn facts about the life cycle of a frog.

Frogs are amphibians, animals that live part of their lives underwater and part on land. Frogs start their lives as eggs that are laid in water. They hatch as tadpoles. A tadpole breathes with gills, and has a tail to help it swim and stay underwater. Tadpoles begin to grow legs and wings as they can breathe out of the water as they mature. They then grow into frogs in about 2-4 months old. Frogs do not have some of their tail but they can now breathe as well as their legs. As frogs become adults, they're is completely absorbed into their body.
