Participles - Formation

Participles are **verbal adjectives**. As adjectives, they modify a noun and agree in **case**, **number**, and **gender**. But since they are *verbal* adjectives they also have **tense** and **mood**. In Unit Four you were introduced to one participle: the perfect passive participle. Latin has **four** different participles: the present active, the perfect passive, the future active, and the future passive.

The present active participle is formed by adding -ns to the present stem. Fill in the following chart for each of the four conjugations (the 1st has been done for you).
