TIMELINE

1. 1453 - The Ottoman empire gains control over Constantinople
2. 1501 - Safavid dynasty rules Iran
3. 1609 - The construction of the Blue Mosque under Ahmed II began.
4. 1699 - Ottomans ceded Hungary to Europe in the Treaty of Karlowitz.
5. 1718 - Treaty of Passarowitz signed.
