

Recognizing addition and subtraction fact families up to 9

An **addition** or **subtraction fact family** is a set of related numbers.

1, 2 and 3 make up a fact family.

$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \\ + 1 \\ \hline 3 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{r} 1 \\ + 2 \\ \hline 3 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{r} 3 \\ - 1 \\ \hline 2 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{r} 3 \\ - 2 \\ \hline 1 \end{array}$$

This fact family includes 2 addition facts and 2 subtraction facts.

2 and 4 also make up a fact family.

$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \\ + 2 \\ \hline 4 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{r} 4 \\ - 2 \\ \hline 2 \end{array}$$

This fact family includes just 1 addition fact and 1 subtraction fact.
