Negative

I don't want
You don't want
He doesn't want
She doesn't want
It doesn't want
We don't want
You don't want
They don't want

Do I want...?
Do you want...?
Does he want...?
Does she want...?
Does it want...?
Do we want...?
Do you want...?
Do they want...?
