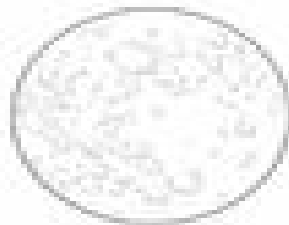
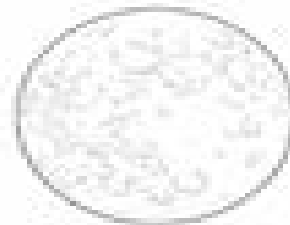


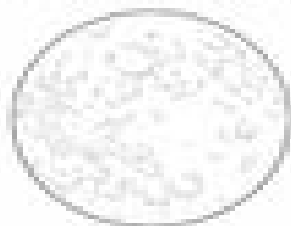
**8. WANING CRESCENT**  
The moon is almost back to its New phase.  
Shade in everything but a tiny crescent on the left.



**1. NEW MOON**  
The moon is facing the same way as the sun, so it looks dark.  
Shade the entire moon.



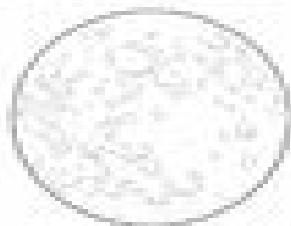
**2. WAXING CRESCENT**  
The moon is becoming visible from Earth, but we can only see a small piece of it.  
Draw a tiny crescent shape on the right, then shade the rest.



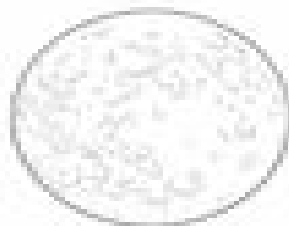
**7. LAST QUARTER**  
We can see a "half moon" again, with the visible side on the left.  
Shade in the right half.



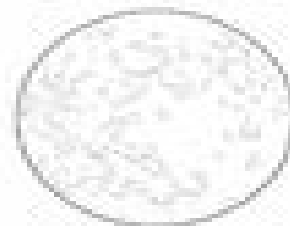
**3. QUARTER MOON**  
The moon is now 3/4 of the way around the Earth, and we can see the right half of it.  
Shade in the left half.



**6. WAXING GIBBOUS**  
The moon begins to darken again.  
Draw a crescent on the right, then shade it in.



**5. FULL MOON**  
We can see the entire side of the moon.  
Leave the moon blank.



**4. WANING GIBBOUS**  
The moon appears almost full.  
Draw a crescent on the left, then shade it in.
