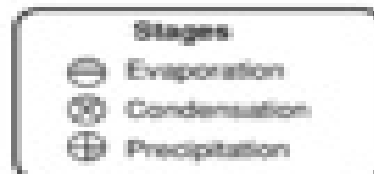
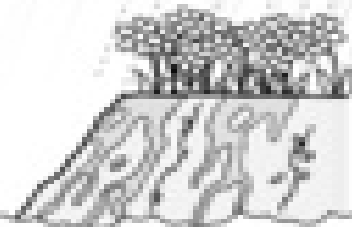


## A Perfect Example
