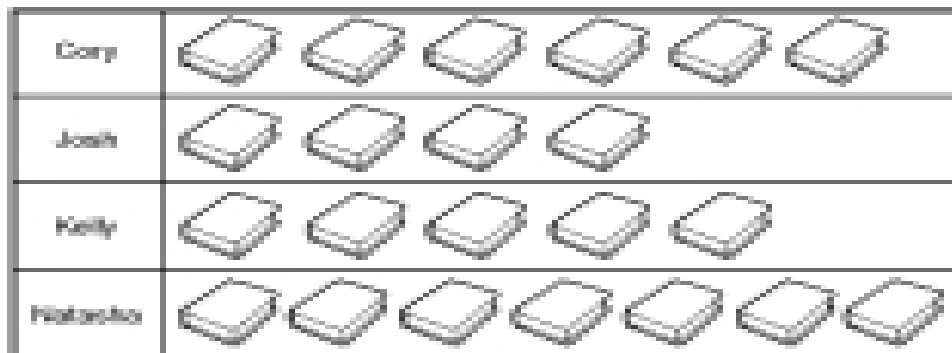


Directions: A pictograph is a diagram, using pictures, that shows the relationship between a number of objects or people. Study and discuss the pictograph. Then use it to answer the questions.
