

What is a limerick?

- A limerick is a five-line poem with a strict meter.
- The rhyme scheme is usually A-A-B-B-A
- What does that mean?
- Lines 1&2 end with the same rhyme, lines 3&4 end with the same rhyme and the last line ends with the same rhyme as the first line.
