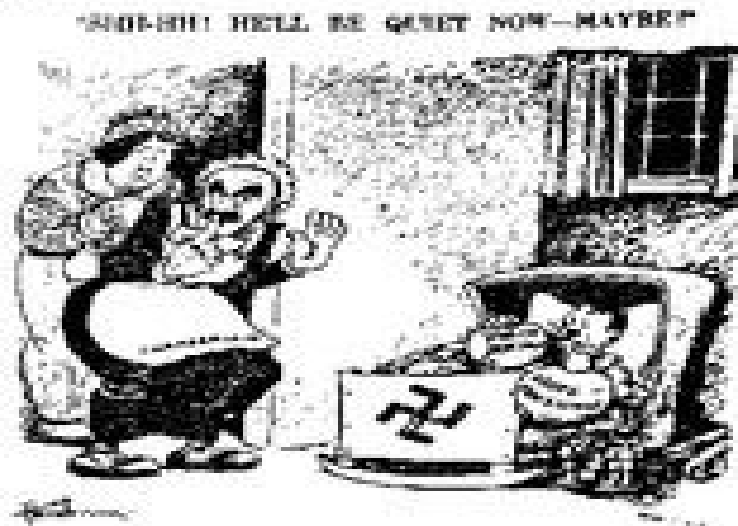


The Munich Agreement
