Underlining Simple Subjects Worksheet 2

The simple subject tells *who* or *what* the sentence is about, but does not include all of the descriptive words within a complete subject. The simple subject is often a single noun.

Example:

The brown bear scurried up the mountain.

simple subject = *bear*
