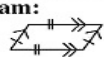
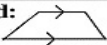

| <b>Trapezoid:</b>  <p>A quadrilateral with one pair of parallel sides.</p>                                             | <b>Rhombus:</b>  <p>A quadrilateral with all sides of equal length.</p>                                              | <b>Quadrilateral:</b>  <p>A polygon with four sides.</p>                                                                              | <b>Kite:</b>  <p>A quadrilateral with two pairs of consecutive, equal sides.</p>                                       |
| <b>Regular Pentagon:</b>  <p>A five-sided polygon with all sides of equal length and all angles of equal measure.</p> | <b>Regular Hexagon:</b>  <p>A six-sided polygon with all sides of equal length and all angles of equal measure.</p> | <b>Isosceles Trapezoid:</b>  <p>A quadrilateral that has two sides that are parallel, and the other two sides have equal length.</p> | <b>Circle:</b>  <p>The set of points equidistant from a central point.</p>                                            |
