### Biography Worksheet, Biography Cubes, Presentations Grading

This portion of the project is worth 100 points.

Each section of the worksheet is worth ten points. To earn ten points, the student must answer all of the questions in each section fully. One point will be deducted for unanswered questions and incomplete answers.

# **Bibliography:** 5 Points

Students are required to use at least one magazine article, one book, and one reputable website. Students must write down the titles of these resources as they work. In order to receive the full five points, they must use the required resources and turn in a list of them. For each required resource that is not used, one point will be deducted.

# **Biography Cubes:** 10 Points

Students are required to fill in information about their music on each side of a paper cube and assemble it. If the cube is assembled, and all information is filled out, then a full 10 points will be given. For each piece of information not included, one point will be deducted.

# **Presentations:** 10 Points

The students will be interviewed as their musician by Mrs. London & Mrs. Beddoe. If the student interviews as their musician and answers prepared questions, then they will be given the 10 points. If the student is not prepared, but does the interview, they will be given 5 points.

## **Student Participation:** 5 Points

Students will be responsible for answering questions about the different musicians interviewed during presentations.

<u>Student Performances:</u> 10 Points Extra Credit The student performs a piece of music and/or dresses like their musician
