

# DESERT PLANTS AND ANIMALS

**Target:** You will understand how animals and plants adapt to a lack of water.



**Animals and plants that live in the desert turn to page 16 with every little water.**

Find out how they survive:

## Thorny devil

This lizard can trap raindrops or dew in the folds in its skin. The water can then run into its mouth.

## Cactus

The cactus's thin leaves or spines reduces water loss. It also stores water in its stem. The thick waxy coating of the cactus stops water from evaporating.

## Budgerigar

Budgerigars usually nest only after rainfall. They drink dew from leaves during drought.

## Shrub's desert pea

The Shrub's desert pea grows in places where water collects, like rocky hillsides. It also has a long tap root to find water underground.
