WORD	DEFINITION(S)
participating	<p>To take part in; be a part of</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> I enjoy <b>participating</b> in the softball games on the playground.</p>
permission	<p>Telling someone they are allowed to do something</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> You have to have your parents' <b>permission</b> before going on the field trip.</p>
personal	<p>Has to do with a particular person</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> The books in the classroom are my <b>personal</b> copies.</p>
petroleum	<p>An oily, thick, flammable liquid many times found by drilling</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> When drillers have a hard time finding <b>petroleum</b>, our gas prices go up.</p>
pier	<p>A structure built on posts that reach from land over the water.</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> I like to do my fishing from the <b>pier</b>.</p>
poked	<p>To push with a finger or an object; To extend or reach out</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> The boy sitting beside me continuously <b>poked</b> my arm with his pencil. She <b>poked</b> her head around the corner.</p>
politician	<p>A person who holds a public office</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> The <b>politician</b> created many commercials before the elections to try to gain votes from the people.</p>
porch	<p>An outside addition to a house</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> I like to sit on the front <b>porch</b> in the summer and watch the people walk by.</p>
precious	<p>Having a high price or valuable; meaning a lot to someone</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> We saw the <b>precious</b> gems at the museum.</p>
preparation	<p>To get ready</p> <p><i>Ex:</i> There is a lot of <b>preparation</b> for setting up a science lab.</p>
