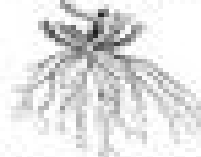

### Get to the root of the base word!



Root and base words are the words T-R-O-O-T.  
They are the part of a word that most often come in another word.

**Examples:**  
Candy (T-R-O-O-T), cross (T-R-O-O-T), unhappy (T-R-O-O-T)
