# Inflectional Endings



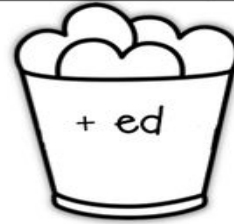
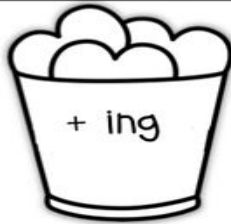
Directions: Read each action word. Write the new endings for each word.
