

4. Any form of water that falls from clouds and reaches the ground.
6. Frozen rain droplets created by the up drafts of convective thunderstorms.
8. A boomerang or crashing noise caused by air impacting along the path of a bolt of lightning.
10. Any wind that changes direction with the seasons.
11. Droplets of water vapor suspended in the air near the ground.
12. Tropical cyclones that blow in a large spiral around a relatively calm center eye.
15. The physical process by which vapor becomes liquid or solid; the opposite of evaporation.

1. The process by which water in plants is transformed as water vapor to the atmosphere.
2. Visible electrical releases created by thunderstorms.
3. Frozen precipitation in the form of white or translucent ice crystals.
5. An arc of colored light in the sky caused by reflection of the sun's rays by rain.
