

Business Etiquette

Review the following etiquette with your partner and decide if it's more French (F) or British (B).

1. **Arrivals.** When business visitors give their business card, it is polite and respectful to take it over and remember the name of your host/hosting.

6. **Photography.** Before taking photos they tend to comment to all the best qualities in the photo.

8. **Drinks.** It is rarely accepted to have breakfast meetings.
9. **Cigarettes.** It is very common for colleagues to go out together after work to have a drink.
