I. CAUSE AND EFFECT POEM:

A. one word	Leaves
B. two words	Foot, shell
C. three words	Foot to earth
D. four words	The leaves have
E. five words	Failed to rise
F. six words	Orange, Brown
G. seven words	Foot

II. CAUSE AND EFFECT Poem: (needs 3 cause-and-effect statements)

Because a little girl's shoe was untied,
She tripped and fell.
Because she tripped and fell,
She crushed a yellow daisy.
Because she crushed a yellow daisy,
There was no "let" for a tomorrow.
Because there was no "let",
It has got me and nothing is left to carry a color.
Because the letter along the hills,
She dropped the color on the sidewalk.

III. PERSONIFICATION POEM: When can human objects (blocks, grass, legs and give human characteristics (singer, shouting, whispering). Remember to describe the object as if it were a person.

Examples:
