

Fact and Opinion

Fact: It can prove it!

An statement about something that can be directly observed by others or checked for accuracy (e.g. numbers).

No. They can be found in encyclopedias, atlases, atlases and textbooks, and they can be observed by you (and others).

Opinion - Fact = Feelings

An statement of influence that is NOT provable if it is mixed with our other facts.

No. They cannot be found in encyclopedias, atlases, atlases and textbooks, opinions just everywhere else), and they can be made by you.

Opinion - Fact = Fact

An opinion contains these words like this.

No. They could be described as "selected pieces found in supporting evidence". Examples, decisions, you and me; and anything else makes influence strongly off.

Opinion - no influence

A fact contains this word right in the beginning of the sentence:

- This is a true fact.
- This is a false fact.
- This is a good fact for you.
