1. Jane likes swimming and / or do I
2. Sue doesn't like chocolate
3. John doesn't eat grapes
4. Sara likes watching movies
5. Maria doesn't have a car
6. They don't have a dog
7. She likes cats
8. She doesn't like coffee
9. He plays football
10. Sally doesn't like cold weather

(B) **and** or **does** he / **and** neither **does** she / **but** he **does** / **but** she **doesn't**
or do you / **do** we / **do** they / **neither** do you, we, they / **but** you, we, they **do**?

1. Jimmy watches TV too often but / but doesn't (but +)
2. Jimmy never eats his lunch (never +)
3. Bill often goes swimming when it's cold (often +)
4. Mike doesn't like pizza (don't +)
5. Malcolm goes running every morning (he goes +)
6. We never go to the movies (they +)
7. I often eat cheese (she +)
8. Their garden looks beautiful (we're +)
9. We don't go out for dinner very often (they +)
