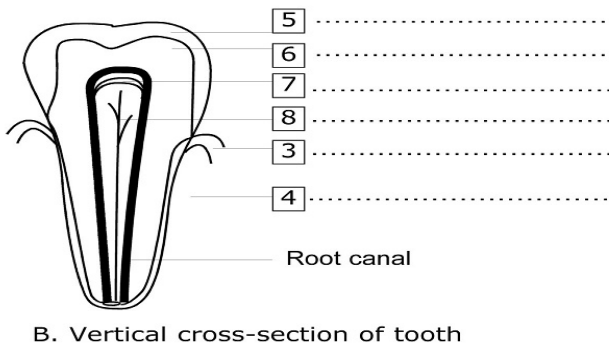
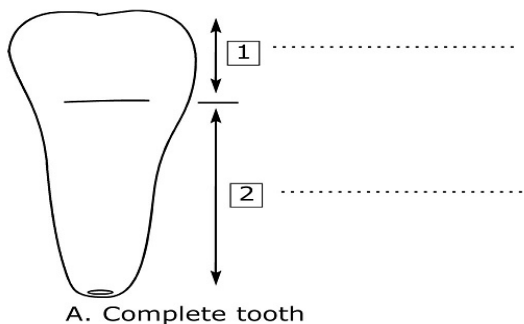


Teeth and Health

Primary Teeth, Permanent Teeth

At 2 years, a child may have 20 milk teeth.
 At 6 years, the first permanent teeth appear.
 At 12 years, a child may have 28 permanent teeth.
 An adult has 32 teeth: 28 teeth plus 4 wisdom teeth. A full set of wisdom teeth does not always appear.
