- ring-shaped island formed by coral buildup on the rim of an underwater volcano
- piece of land that is surrounded by water on three sides
- dry areas of land, desolate, waterless, with little vegetation
- an inland, grassland area
- body of water that is partly enclosed by land with a wide outlet to the ocean
- long, wide body of water connecting larger bodies of water
- deep, narrow valley with high steep walls
- wet, treeless plains with permafrost and small, low plants
- hill that rises abruptly from surrounding area with steep sides and a flat top
