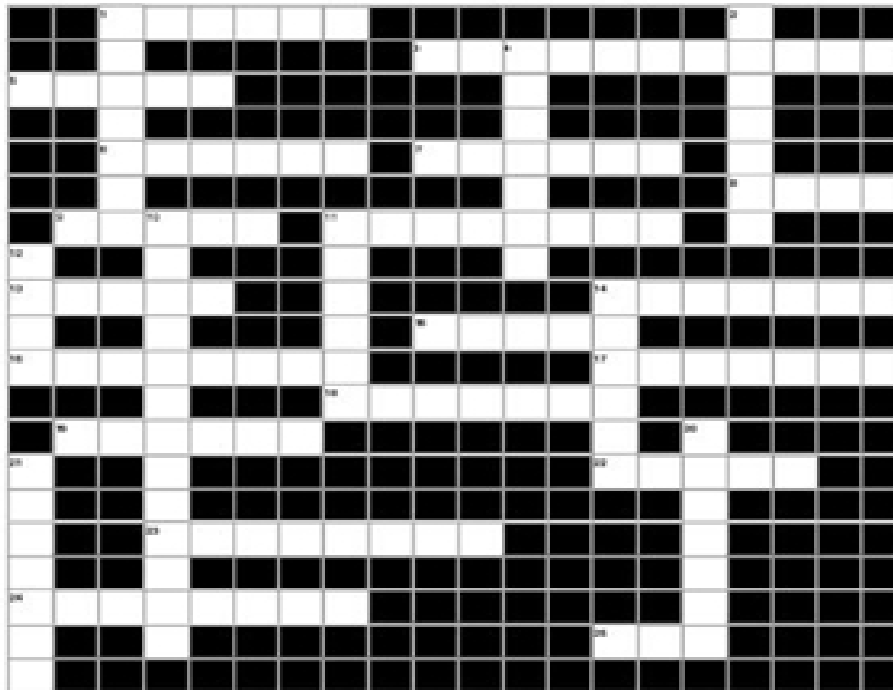


## CRIME PUZZLE
