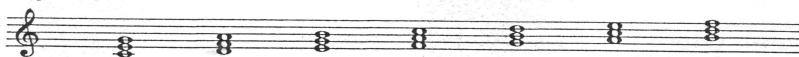

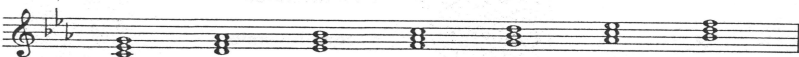
## Diatonic Triads

Major



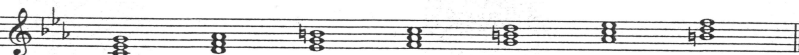

Natural Minor



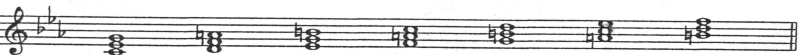

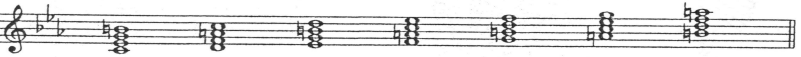
