- future predictions
- future promises
- future offers
- future obligations
- future intentions

Examples:

1. I **will** finish my homework tonight.

2. She **will** be married next year.

3. He **will** give me the book when he returns.

going to

going to is used to talk about:

- future plans
- future intentions
- future predictions (based on evidence)

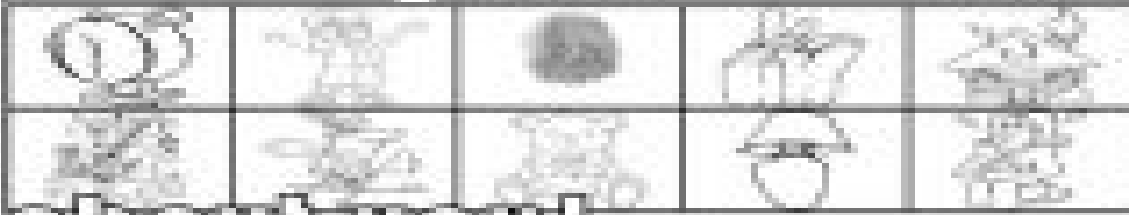
Examples:
