Predicate Adjectives

A Predicate Adjective is a describing word that occurs after the verb and goes back to describe the subject of the sentence.

ې.^{م.} My wagon is red.

ې.^م. The man **felt** sick.

ې.ك. Sharp cheese tastes good.

Birds in our backyard sounded ρ . A. happy.

 $\rho.A.$ $\rho.A.$ $\rho.A.$ Our flag is red, white, and blue.

The tired child became sleepy $\rho.^{A.}$ and restless.

The sentence MUST contain a linking verb for there to be a P.A.
