Star Tracer	Tracing a pattern using reflection tests hand eye coordination and left/right brain functioning
String Strobe	Learn about wave rotation, effects of light, deductive reasoning and investigative skills
Toddler Play Area	Rotating challenges from puzzles to lock boxes keep toddlers learning
Strobe Fan	Learn about the effects of light and speed on patterns, rotation, investigative skills, and art creativity
Tool Touch	Deductive reasoning, investigative skills, tool identification and matching by touch
Touch for Sound	Cause and effect and sound identification by touch
Walking Piano	Musical learning, gross motor skills, and cause & effect as students compose their own music with their feet
Wheel Chair Racer	Gross motor skills and disability sensitivity experience give students the experience of being wheelchair bound
